



# **GUIDELINES AND REGULATIONS**

## **GENERAL ADVICE ON ACCREDITATION**

- Accreditation is generally awarded to people who can provide **evidence of their journalistic work**. For this reason, please note that applications without the corresponding supporting documents and with incomplete information will not be processed.
- Amateur photographers and photographers and video crews who do not work on a journalistic basis will not be accredited.
- A maximum of two media representatives can be accredited per editorial office. However, reviews of individual cases by the press office are possible.
- There is no right to accreditation. Hockenheim-Ring GmbH retains the right to refuse accreditations without providing justification.

## **SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS REQUIRED**

- **Official press pass from a recognised association.** Only press passes valid for 2018 will be recognised
- **Editorial assignment** with the current date and signature of the editor-in-chief or editor. Alternatively, documents (articles, photos) with a clear copyright notice may be submitted. The documents submitted will be inspected.
- **Signed disclaimer.** The original signature of the media representative is mandatory on the disclaimer.

## **PHOTOGRAPHERS AND TV CREWS**

Photographers and television crews also require a photographer's bib, which should be worn clearly at all times in the track area. The photographer's bib can be obtained on site in the press centre for a deposit of 50 EUR per bib. Please note that the photographer's bib can only be collected and returned during the times indicated on-site.

## **USE OF DRONES**

The use of drones, microcopters and similar unmanned flying objects is prohibited in motorsport events.
